## What is the course about?

The MSc in Project Management is aimed at preparing students who possess, a primary degree, with the Project Management competencies and skills set to take up employment and engage in projects immediately on entering the workplace.

The Programme provides graduates with contemporary project management approaches, the development of theories and principles, deepening of and application of knowledge, skills set and ability to critically analyse and engage actively in the development and integration of project management as a way of work within organisations.

## Entry Requirements

Minimum of a 2.2 honours primary degree in a project management related field, such as engineering, science, business, information technology, public administration, health and education etc. Candidates may be selected for interview to determine suitability.

Applicants who cannot satisfy the minimum 2:2 honours primary degree requirement may be accepted on the basis of Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL).
