Department of Electronic and Computer Engineering

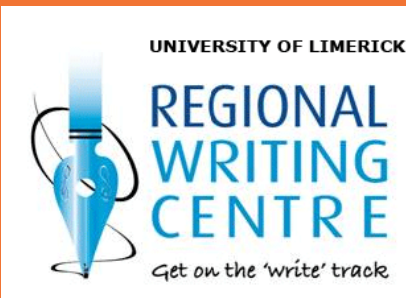
