This innovative fully online Master programme is designed to enable teachers, with experience of working in EU and Non EU settings, to obtain a professional qualification that will enhance their career opportunities.

The programme builds on the student's experience of international educational systems and enhances their professional and leadership skills, whilst providing a supportive learning environment.

## Who should do this course?

Teachers who have worked in international settings who are seeking to update their knowledge and understanding of education policy and practice.

Teachers who may seek promotion opportunities at middle or senior management levels.

### Teachers completing this course will:

- Gain deeper understanding of educational leadership approaches to critically appraise policy, professional practice and models of effective leadership.
- Appreciate the opportunities for entrepreneurial approaches to leading educational change and for building cultures of leadership through their practice.
- Use key capacity building practices within their school, and professional networks to foster inclusive and supportive leadership.
- Acquire change management skills to enable organisational innovation and drive positive change.
- Engage with empowerment strategies such as coaching to maximise school effectiveness.
- Understand and utilise the dynamics of resource optimisation in the achievement of individual and organisational goals.
