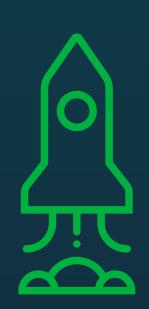
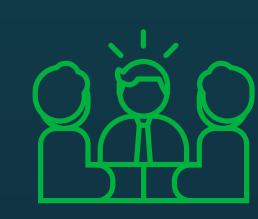

Participant Nomination

The sending university nominates the participant to UL Global. UL Global will assist in finding a host if needed.

The incoming participant can now apply for the necessary travel documents for the visit using the supporting documentation provided by UL Global.

Apply for Travel

Documents

UL Global Info

UL Global will send/collect pertinent information to/from the participant (formerly known as the nominee). this info may be in relation to visas, funding, or a schedule of activities.

Teaching or Training Agreement

The nominee and host must complete a teaching/training agreement. The host, nominee, and sending organization must sign the agreement and submit it to UL Global for review. Upon successful review UL Global will sign the completed agreement.

UL Global will submit necessary documentation to the Erasmus+ Mobility Tool.

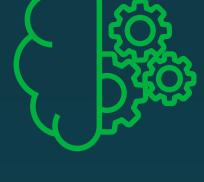
Contract Signing

UL Global will issue the Grant Agreement/Contract. The participant must sign the contract and submit it to UL Global, who will in turn sign the contract and return it to the participant.

The Grant

UL Global requests the grant payment from the UL Finance Department in time for the participants arrival. Upon receiving the grant the participant signs the grant acknowledgement and submits boarding cards.

After returning to their home organisation, the participant is to complete a final report and submit their return boarding cards to UL Global.
