Spring Semester

The Qualifier module (Professional Portfolio PP8001) involves a reflective component exploring the following:

- What is a doctorate?
- How to develop a professional portfolio.
- What is knowledge academic and professional knowledge?
- Philosophy of research. Professional development.
- The Engineer as a Professional. Delivering a unique contribution to professional knowledge.
- Identification and assessment of on-going research within their profession; Engineering Ethics, Engineers in Society, Responsibility in Engineering.

Module is delivered over a 8 week period.

There is a 1-day workshop followed by support sessions (one-to-one, group, on-campus or online as necessary), to develop a Research Proposal.

Participants will be required to identify a problem that is significant to their industry or profession to propose an appropriate approach to solving this problem. This problem definition will form the basis of a submission to the Professional Doctorate (Engineering) - PDEng Academic Board.

The module will be assessed on a pass/fail basis after paper submission and presentation to the Academic Board.
