The Arc Accountability Research Cluster at the Kemmy Business School, University of Limerick, Ireland is delighted to announce the third CSEAR Ireland conference, to be held online between October 22 2021.

The conference theme, Building (Back) for the Common Good, recognises the potential of accounting and accountability in their widest framings to contribute to a better world as we emerge from the Covid-19 pandemic. We aim to provide a supportive and intellectually engaging forum which fosters both emerging and established research. In keeping with the traditions of CSEAR, we invite diverse methodological approaches and interdisciplinary work that contributes to our understanding of social and environmental accounting, and the societal impact of accounting and accountability. Practice-focused and practical work, particularly with an emphasis on ways of building back better from the current crisis, as well as theoretical papers are especially welcome.

The conference will feature a keynote panel on the conference theme of Building (back?) for the Common Good, featuring Prof. **Charles Cho**, of Schulich School of Business, York University; Prof. **Kathryn Haynes** of Northumbria University; and **Ben Philips** author of *How to Fight Inequality*.

Due to the Covid Pandemic and to facilitate inclusive participation, the conference will be held online. However, we will endeavour to ensure that there is a flavour of Ireland and of Limerick in the online experience.
