### Entry Requirements

Normally applicants will possess a minimum 2:2 honours primary degree in a relevant discipline (for example, business, finance, economics, social science and mathematics). However, students from cognate backgrounds are also encouraged to apply. In exceptional circumstances an applicant who cannot satisfy the undergraduate requirement may be accepted on the basis of relevant professional experience.

In the case of international students, the overseas equivalent as determined by the Course Team in consultation with UL Graduate School Admissions will be acceptable.

Where candidates are non-native English language speakers, the candidate should meet the University's English language requirements.
