Limited evidence of wider reading.</li> <li>Reasonable analytical and interpretative skills.</li> <li>The work is still of sufficient standard to merit an honours award.</li> </ul>

Little or no evidence of wider reading.</li> <li>A basic knowledge of key principles and concepts only.</li> <li>Limited analytical and interpretative skills.</li> </ul>
