DEVELOPING SELF AS A HEALTHCARE PRACTITIONER School of Nursing & Midwifery

Duration: 3 weeks | Credits: 6 ECTS/3 US

This summer school interweaves a Celtic spiritual dimension to healthcare exploring the psychosocial, cultural and spiritual elements in developing personal and professional practice. Developing emotional intelligence offers a foundation towards transforming self and caring practice. Engaging in visits to practice areas aims to inform understanding of the potential application of this approach in developing self in practice. The summer school aims to foster an engaged, connected learning environment in the spirit of creativity, dialogue and diversity through a variety of learning and teaching strategies. **Minimum number of students - 10 (Updated 10/01/2022)**

BUSINESS

International Financial Markets and Trading - Bloomberg Certification (BESS & BMC)

Kemmy Business School

Duration: 3 weeks | Credits: 6 ECTS/3 US

This summer school provides an introduction to international financial markets and emphasizes the investment decision process as framed by behavioral finance. Topics may include behavioural finance and the flaws of human judgement; ethical investment choices; market risk; CSR and governance. The use of real-time sophisticated trading and investment software on the KBS Trading Floor will allow the student to gain practical trading experience and a commanding view of the global financial arena.

Bloomberg Certificates are awarded to attendees as well as an official transcript. (Updated 10/01/2022)

LAW



TERRORISM, CRIME AND JUSTICE School of Law

Duration: 3 weeks | Credits: 6 ECTS/3 US

Terrorism represents one of the most challenging international crimes in contemporary times. This summer school will introduce students to the criminal justice system and theories relating to crime and terrorism. It will include an introduction to criminological and penological theories. In particular drawing on Irish experience, students will be provided with an insight into trends and theories on terrorism. (Updated the 10/01/2022)

TAKING ACTION: CAMPAIGNING FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE ISSUES

Duration: 3 weeks | Credits: 6 ECTS/3 US

Summer School 2022 is delighted to offer the new summer school module. This module offers student opportunities to explore a range of global issues of interest and concern to youth today in areas including climate change, migration, identity and inclusion, and well-being and mental health, and to develop knowledge and strategies in relating to social media journalism and social media campaigning. You will develop acritical awareness of these issues and practical training is provided in relation to the skills and tools needed to build a related social media campaign. You will go on to build a social media campaign on one of the content themes in collaboration with peers drawing on a wide range of cutting-edge digital tools and your newfound knowledge and skills, in a supportive and guided environment, with opportunities to showcase your campaign for awareness raising purpose.

MODERN IRISH THEATRE

Duration: 3 weeks | Credits: 6 ECTS/3 US

Irish theatre from the beginning of the Irish Literary Theatre in 1899 to 1999. This course will provide an introduction to Irish drama in the 20th Century as well as explore the relationship of Irish nationalism and Irish theatre. Students will attend professional theatre productions in Dublin. (Updated on 10/01/2022)

IRISH LIFE AND LITERATURE

Duration: 3 weeks | Credits: 6 ECTS/3 US

Analyse and contextualise the culture, history and traditions of modern Ireland. This module will offer students an opportunity to explore, analyse and contextualise the culture, history and traditions of modern Ireland. Assesses writers, explores social, political and economic developments and discusses folklore, music and song in a supportive and guided environment.

Irish Traditions, Folklore & Culture

Duration: 3 weeks | Credits: 6 ECTS/3 US

Ireland is well-known for its rich traditions and culture, including themes around dance, folklore, music and festivals. Join this module for a journey of mythical stories and cultural themes, and participate in workshops on Irish dancing, hurling and storytelling. Students can immerse themselves in an Irish, cultural experience, experiencing the sights and sounds of Ireland whilst learning about the importance of legends, music and sport. Optional visits to the most iconic destinations complete this lively, engaging and unforgettable module.
