Insurance requirements for incoming exchange students	<p>Yes. There is an insurance requirement. The International Student Office will need to verify that your private health insurance coverage is comparable to the policy provided by the university. You must bring a copy of your policy coverage with you when you drop off your proof of insurance. The University Health Insurance Plan is the only insurance plan accepted in the Wellness Center, waiving the University Health Insurance Plan may result in greater upfront costs when visiting on-campus health facilities and in the community, please check provider information if you choose to waive.</p> <p>The written proof of insurance must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have a central US office or offer easily accessible coverage that pays upfront costs <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ If it does not meet this requirement, the plan will be

	<p>waived only at the discretion of the university. It must be understood that in this case all costs must be paid by the patient upon treatment and are eventually reimbursed by the patient's insurance company. If insurance coverage cannot be verified, treatment could be denied.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cover at least \$500,000 per accident/illness per calendar year • Cover Medical evacuation • Cover Repatriation of remains
Immigration	Exchange students will need a J (exchange) visa. Instructions and documents needed to apply for the J visa will be mailed upon acceptance into the program.
