

Credit system

In Sweden, full-time students take 30 Swedish credits/30 ECTS credits per semester, or 60 Swedish/60 ECTS credits per year. Students can take a maximum of 45 ECTS-credits per semester. In all courses given in English, students will be given final grades according to the ECTS scale.

Marks at Södertörn University are generally given on a three-point scale:

- Pass with distinction (VG)
- Pass (G)
- Fail (U)

The three-point scale is transferred into the ECTS scale in the following way:

- A - Pass with distinction (VG)
- B - Pass with distinction (VG)
- C - Pass (G)
- D - Pass (G)
- E - Pass (G)
- F - Fail (U)

NOTE! Credits are awarded only when the course has been completed and all required examinations have been successfully taken.
