<p><b>Insurance requirements for incoming exchange students</b></p>	<p>Every J-1 international student is required to have health insurance. If you already have a health care provider who will cover you while studying overseas at Robert Morris University, you need to provide that information.</p> <p>The University does provide a health care carrier for those students who do not have coverage. International students will be enrolled in this insurance upon registration at RMU if proof of other insurance is not provided and the premium amount will be posted to your account.</p>
