Dear colleagues,

While no official decision has been communicated yet from the Government, it is clear that Level 5 restrictions are going to continue beyond the end of January.

The <u>B&E Restricted Access Procedure</u> continues to apply for the first two weeks of term. Everything is closed with the exception of buildings where face-to-face teaching is taking place. There is a very useful diagram available <u>here</u> from Cornell University that clearly demonstrates that the most effective measures in preventing the spread of COVID-19 is to stay at home.

If you are teaching face-to-face, even in a mechanically ventilated room, opening windows is a simple and effective action that can be taken to help reduce the spread of the virus. The recommendation is that you should open windows in your area on commencing work and close when finishing up for the day.

An update on Special Leave with Pay is available on the UL COVID-19 website. Special leave with pay should only apply in lieu of sick leave for COVID-19 when an employee is advised to self-isolate **and** is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or had a positive test. More detail on special leave with pay is available in the new <u>Government Publications</u> folder on the COVID-19 SharePoint site.
