



Once you sign in to Core Portal ESS, you will see the below home page

You will then see the below options – “Pension Landing” and “Pension Statement”




If you click on “Pension Statement” you will see your estimated pension benefits calculated as at 30<sup>th</sup> September after your 70<sup>th</sup> Birthday.



## 2. My Personal Details

Provides information on your personal/pension details

Date of Birth (Your DOB)

Date Joined Pensions (this is the date you commenced in the pension scheme. If you purchased temporary service for non-pensionable employment prior to joining the scheme, this will be reflected in the pension calculator under "Temporary Service")

Date of Retirement (set as 30<sup>th</sup> September after your 70<sup>th</sup> Birthday)

Date of Calculation (today's date)

Pensionable Salary (your salary that your pension is calculated on. This will be your current salary or may be an average salary if you changed grades in the last 3 years)

### 3. Notional Service Calculator (only available for members of pre-2013 schemes)

You can generate a quote for Notional Service by clicking the looking glass on the right of the Notional Service Calculator.

You can update the "Amount of service to purchase", "Purchase Age" (either to age 60 or 65) and "Method" (Periodic or Lump Sum purchase). You then must accept the disclaimer and press "Calculate".
