NOMINATION DEADLINES

There is no nomination deadline.

Faculty 06 will contact nominated students directly by early July (for the winter term) and early January (for the summer term), sending them an information package regarding application, housing, registration and necessary documents. Faculty 06 only accepts applications sent in by traditional mail (no online registration).

An orientation week is planned to welcome exchange students only at the beginning of the winter term (the week before the lecture period). Attendance to these sessions is strongly recommended.

TRANSCRIPTS OF RECORDS

A Transcript of Records will be issued no later than 8 weeks after the assessment period has finished at our institution.

TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

COST OF LIVING

Students should plan the following monthly expenses (approximate):

- Housing: starting by 200 € (shared flat) or 240 € (students' residence)
- Transport: Students' tickets (covers all public transport in the region during 6 months, Faculty 06 students can choose from two different regions), approx. 120 €
- Other expenses depending on individual life style.

INTEGRATION ACTIVITIES

The [Buddy-Project at Faculty 06](#) provides incoming exchange students with a German "buddy" and organizes leisure and cultural activities (for participation, an online-registration is needed).

ENROLMENT

Students will enroll by the second lecture week through the International Office Germersheim (specific information for each term will be sent directly to the incoming students).

Due to the geographical situation of the Germersheim Campus (approx. 100 km south of Mainz) it is not possible to attend courses at other faculties of Johannes Gutenberg University.

GRADING SYSTEM

Our grading system is based on a scale from 1,0 to 5,0. The minimum passing mark is 4,0.

1,0 to 1,3 – outstanding | 1,7 to 2,3 – good | 2,7 to 3,3 – regular | 3,7 to 4,0 – passed | 5,0 – suspense

In some courses no marks are given, only "passed" or "suspense" and the respective ECTS credits.
