Exchange candidates need to go to the [Prospect Oasis website](#) and create an account with their personal email address. When the student logs in, they'll need to complete some personal details. At the end of this pre-enrolment process, the home institution will be requested to approve (or reject) the application. This approval will serve as nomination.

After the approval of the home institution, exchange candidates will be able to proceed with the application after logging in at the [Prospect Oasis website](#) with the login they created in step 1.

What is new:

- Almost 80% from our exchange programme consists of Master courses!
- Bachelor students can only access Master courses if they can provide proof that they meet the initial competences to access the course.
- Courses in the field of Business Economics will be taught in a modular schedule and with permanent evaluation! This means that it will be difficult to match with timetables in other study fields.
- Learning Agreement: we only accept LA's with minimum 24 credits (in table A and B!). The study programme can only consist of courses (no internship, thesis, ...). Max. 40% of credits in the LA can be selected from other faculties.

Important:

- The exam results from our incoming exchange students are taken into account in the permanent evaluation of our partner network (implemented by UGent since AY '14-'15)
- Titles from our courses don't always reflect the content! It is crucial to read the course specifications and initial competences of each course (when published: click on a subject of your choice in the course catalogue and a pdf-file pops up)
- The English language level (speaking and writing!) of your selected students must be level B2 upon application.
- TOEFL or TOEIC-attestations are highly recommended unless the student has already completed an English taught semester/year.
