

Dear student,

I am pleased to inform that you have been accepted by the Universidad de Valladolid to participate in the ERASMUS+ exchange programme signed by your University and the Universidad de Valladolid for the academic year 2016/2017.

PLEASE, FOLLOW THESE STEPS TO REGISTER CORRECTLY:

1. You must fill the Foreign Students Register Form, which is available at the web page: [www.relint.uva.es/incoming/inicio.asp?idioma=en](http://www.relint.uva.es/incoming/inicio.asp?idioma=en) At the same site you will be able to choose the kind of accommodation you prefer.
2. After sending the registration form electronically it must be printed, signed and mailed to [mariafatima.arevalo@uva.es](mailto:mariafatima.arevalo@uva.es) or [miguelpablo.souto@uva.es](mailto:miguelpablo.souto@uva.es) attaching a photograph, a copy of your identity card and a document which makes prove of your B1 level of Spanish language, by June the 30th for full academic year or first term students or by December the 31st for second term students.

Note: If you cannot send the certificate of Spanish along with the other documents before June 30, I advise you to study very hard before coming to Spain to be able to provide the certificate of your Spanish skills on arrival.

If you don't get an official certificate of your level, you can submit a report of a Spanish professor from your home University informing that you have sufficient knowledge of Spanish to fulfill successfully your stay at our University.

Another option to obtain an adequate level of Spanish is to follow an intensive Spanish course at a language school in Valladolid before the academic year begins.

3. Please, note that after being registered your Personal Area will be available at [www.relint.uva.es/estudiantesExtranjeros/area/intranet/inicio.asp?idioma=en](http://www.relint.uva.es/estudiantesExtranjeros/area/intranet/inicio.asp?idioma=en) There you will find updated information about your personal academic status, accommodation, your academic advisor, etc..

The calendar for the 2016-2017 Academic Year hasn't been decided, but will be very similar to that of academic year 2015-2016:

The 2015-2016 Academic Year of the Universidad de Valladolid starts on 9th September 2015 and finishes 24th of June 2016. It is divided into two terms:

- First term: 9th September 2015 until 22nd January 2016  
First term resit examination will be held from 1 to 12 February

- Second term: 15th February 2016 until 24th of June 2016  
Second term resit examination will be held from 4 to 15 July

In September there will be an Orientation Day for first semester and whole year international students (Erasmus+, Visiting, Bilateral Agreements.....). In February an Orientation Day will be held for second semester students.

Enrolment period: Students wishing to study in the first semester or in the whole year must enrol in September, students wishing to study in the second semester must enrol in February. All students are required to pay the officially established fees for extra services: Opening of student file, Student Card, Student Insurance, and Administrative General Expenses. The amount for 2015-2016 was 61.22 Euros. These fees must be paid after being enrolled. Students with no medical insurance cannot be enrolled. We expect the extra services fees for academic year 2016-2017 to be very similar to 2015-2016.

Please note that students, who would like to study at the University of Valladolid, must have a B1 level of Spanish (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages - CEFR), because most of the courses are given in Spanish.
