

ERASMUS EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

Eligibility for ERASMUS exchange

University of Wuppertal (BUW) takes an active part in ERASMUS exchanges with European partner universities. The BUW only accepts ERASMUS exchange students from institutions of higher education for which an "ERASMUS bilateral agreement" within a specific subject area exists for the respective academic year.

Please contact the ERASMUS co-ordinator of your home university to check whether a bilateral agreement with BUW is existent,

If there is no such agreement with your home institution, get in touch with the ERASMUS co-ordinator of your university to examine whether you can apply as exchange student.

Application to BUW (before arrival)

Your application must be filed at the ERASMUS office of your home university. It will be processed by your co-ordinator as well as the institutional ERASMUS co-ordinator of University of Wuppertal, no other contact person is allowed.

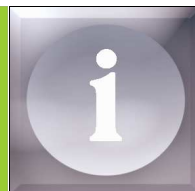
Once your acceptance as ERASMUS student is confirmed by both ERASMUS co-ordinators, you will be sent:

- a set of application forms for ERASMUS students, to be filled and sent back to the institutional ERASMUS co-ordinator of BUW, together with
- some useful information about housing in Wuppertal and detailed instructions on how to apply for accommodation in a student residence hall, including an application form for accommodation.

Only those students who have the authorisation from their own university and are accepted at BUW may enrol as ERASMUS student at BUW, provided we have received the complete set of the required, filled forms.

Hence make sure to send as soon as possible the following documents, properly filled, to the International Office of BUW (address see below):

- your application form for ERASMUS students, and
- your application form for accommodation (if interested in accommodation in a student residence hall).



After arrival in Wuppertal, all ERASMUS students should present themselves, as soon as possible, to the ERASMUS co-ordinator at the International Office (Akademisches Auslandsamt, Campus Griffenberg, building O, floor 06, room 10).

ERASMUS students will be full students of this university in every sense, with the usual privileges and responsibilities attached to this status.
