Types of courses	<p>Vorlesung (VL) / lecture</p> <p>Konversatorium (KO): mostly discussion-based course, preparation on special topics by students</p> <p>Proseminar (PS): see Seminar but lower level and work load</p> <p>Seminar (SE): Introduction to and reading of literature with discussions and test, guided research, paper presentation and discussion, final paper about special subject (20-40 pages) Seminar papers in English in some courses possible</p>
How many courses possible?	<p>ECTS-credits</p> <p>VL/KO: 3 credits PS: 6 credits SE: 8 credits 60 credits are full work load for one year</p>
Examinations	<p>examination (usually at end of each semester for each course)</p> <p>VL: written test, sometimes orals</p> <p>KO: preparation of topics, participation in discussions</p> <p>PS: participation in discussions, presentation, paper, test</p> <p>SE: similar to PS but on higher level</p>
Grades	<p>ECTS-grades:</p> <p>A excellent (10 %) - sehr gut (1) B very good (25 %) gut (2) C good (30 %) befriedigend (3) D satisfactory (25 %) genügend (4) E sufficient, FX fail (can be improved) (10 %) F fail - nicht genügend (5)</p>
Certificate	<p>Students can get an official ECTS-compatible certificate for their studies in Salzburg</p>
