LANGUAGE LEVEL

Language of instruction

Spanish and English

Most of the courses given at ETSIT-UPM at Bachelor level are in Spanish while quite a lot of courses at Master level are available in English (depending on the Masters).

It is advisable to have a Spanish language level equivalent to at least A2/B1 (Common European Framework of Reference for languages).

If following classes in English, the minimum of English level required is B2.

No certificate is required; when signing the learning agreement, the home Institution guarantees that the student has sufficient language knowledge in order to follow courses and pass exams.

Spanish language courses (intensive and regular)

UPM – Prolinter is offering Spanish language courses in two different options:

- Intensive Spanish courses: at the beginning of each academic year during 3 weeks (5 ECTS)
- Regular Spanish courses: weekly along the semester during 4 months (3 ECTS)

Accommodation for incoming students	UPM has a Welcome Center and accommodation offers. At ETSIT, we have a student guide for accommodation written in English, Spanish, Italian and French. It is quite easy to find a shared flat in Madrid (prices between 300€ and 450€/month for the single room). Residences in the campus are available for exchange students and include room cleaning service, dinner, gym, cultural activities and sport facilities as swimming pool (prices between 500 and 800€/month)

Mentor Project	Incoming students are assigned a mentor student to help him/her in his/her first steps and adaptation in his/her student life at ETSIT-UPM. Cultural and sport activities are organized as well as meetings, excursions and parties.
Welcome Day	At the beginning of each semester, the international office of ETSIT organizes a welcome day for all incoming students. During this day, students may fill in the registration form for the University, get information about courses registration, moodle access, students clubs, etc... and have a tour of the School. They also meet their mentor and other incoming students.
