Health Insurance (compulsory)

Please send a copy of your international health insurance with your application. International students who will stay in China for more than 6 months must be medically insured throughout their entire planned period of study.

Visa

- All non-Chinese nationals must apply for a visa to enter China for the purpose of studying. ESSCA, along with our Chinese partners will send students an official invitation letter to apply for a visa.
- Students planning to stay 6 months should apply for Visa X2, with multiple entries if they wish to travel to surrounding countries. Students planning on staying longer than 6 months should apply for Visa X1.

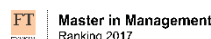
