Health Insurance	<p>For European Students: a copy of your European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)</p> <p>Non-European Students are required to purchase mandatory French health insurance (about 217 € - in 2017-2018) upon arrival at La Rochelle Business School</p> <p>Please note that it is mandatory for all non-European students, between 20 and 28 years old, to buy the French health insurance that will cover them in France, even if they already bought an insurance before departure. Students will be requested to make this payment by credit card or cash upon their arrival.</p>
