



Preferred arrival date	Participation on the introduction programme is urgently recommended to all incoming students
Introduction days	<p>Summer Semester: in the first half of March (1 and a half week for incoming students with Non-EU nationality, 1 week for incoming students with EU nationality)</p> <p>Winter Semester: in the second half of September (1,5 week for incoming students with Non-EU nationality, 1 week for incoming students with EU nationality, 3 weeks for incoming students taking part in the German language intensive course)</p>
Semester Dates (including exams)	<p>Summer Semester: in the first half of March until the end of July</p> <p>Winter Semester: in the end of September until the middle or the second half of February</p>
Nomination deadline	<p>Summer Semester: 15th November</p> <p>Winter Semester: 1st May</p>
Application Deadline	<p>Summer Semester: 1st December</p> <p>Winter Semester: 15th May</p>
Application Procedure	<p>Students will be informed by e-mail after their nomination was delivered by the home institution to io-incomings@hs-heilbronn.de</p> <p>Students have to complete an online Application Form, to register and to upload the required documents. The paper version is to be sent to the International Office <u>before</u> the application deadline.</p>

Possibility of Attending Courses from Different Departments	Our faculties IB and WV are sharing one International Programme for incoming business students they can select of. A combination of both faculties is on request.
Accommodation Arranged	Application for a room in one of our dormitories is possible, but as past showed there are not as many rooms in the students` hall of residence available as exchange students apply for them. We will deliver further information on the search for private accommodation in Heilbronn with the sending of the Letter of Acceptance. Also tutors will help with the search for a private accommodation.
Accommodation cost / month	Student dormitory about 300 €, private accommodation 250 – 450 €
Costs of Living Expenses	About 800 € (incl. rent, food, health insurance, broadcasting, leisure/culture, clothing)
Insurance	A valid health insurance is an obligation for the enrolment , monthly fee about 90 € (not for students with EHIC). A personal liability insurance is recommended.
