Application process	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The home university selects the exchange students and sends a nomination (name, duration of stay, field of study and email address of the nominated students) by email to <a href="mailto:erasmus@fau.de">erasmus@fau.de</a> (Europe and Erasmus+) or <a href="mailto:exchange-overseas@fau.de">exchange-overseas@fau.de</a> (Overseas)</li> <li>2. All nominated students receive information on FAU's application process via email. FAU uses the online application system <b>Mobility Online</b>. The link to the application website will be sent directly to all nominated exchange students.</li> <li>3. The students apply via the Mobility Online Portal: They fill in the application form and upload the documents required. The application has to be submitted within the deadlines.</li> <li>4. Only completed applications can be accepted! Students will be informed about their admission by email (Erasmus) and by regular mail (Non-Erasmus). The letter of admission must be presented during enrolment at FAU.</li> </ol>
Documents required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Transcripts of Records for all semesters completed at a university. If the documents have not been issued in English or German, a (non official) translation in English or German is necessary. If applicable add your Bachelor/Master diploma.</li> <li>• Current certificate of enrolment from your home university</li> <li>• Proof of Language proficiency (German and English). The language and the level required correspond to the bilateral cooperation agreement and depend on the intended course programme at FAU. Official certificates (TOEFL, IELTS, DAF, etc.) or confirmations issued by a professional language teacher with stamp and signature are accepted. Language Requirements	<p>All Exchange students at FAU need to have sufficient knowledge of German <u>and/or</u> English that allows them to take a suitable amount of courses at FAU.</p> <p>Only Non-Erasmus: We generally recommend that exchange students have either completed level A2 in German and/or level B2 in English (corresponds to TOEFL score of at least 80 iBT) before coming to FAU. Please note that the re-</p>

	quired language level may be higher for certain study programmes. For double degree students: in accordance with the corresponding co-operation agreement
Project/Final thesis	Students who are coming to FAU to write their <b>thesis</b> (not to attend classes but e.g. work in a laboratory) additionally have to hand in a confirmation of supervision by a professor of FAU. Non-EU students must prove that they can afford <b>monthly living expenses of at least EUR 720</b> . This minimum amount is determined by German social legislation and must be available to the student in order to apply for a student residence permit or visa with German immigration authorities.

Travel health insurance	<p>Strong recommended for non-EU citizens. The travel health insurance needs to be valid until enrolment at FAU.</p>
Health insurance during the exchange stay	<p><b>Health insurance is obligatory in Germany.</b> Sufficient health insurance is also a prerequisite of enrolling at FAU. Accident and liability insurance is recommended. All policies should cover the entire stay in Germany.</p> <p><b>Please note that international travel insurance policies are not sufficient as health insurance for a study abroad in Germany.</b> EU citizens can keep their national (European) health insurance. Non-EU exchange students under 30 years of age must enroll for a health plan with one of the German statutory student health insurance providers <u>after</u> their arrival in Erlangen/Nuremberg. Non-EU exchange students older than 30 cannot have a statutory student health insurance but only a private one. The costs in both cases are around <b>80 to 150 Euros per month</b>.</p> <p>With a German statutory health insurance provider exchange students can be sure that the health insurance will be recognized by the university, German immigration authorities as well as doctors and hospitals.</p>
Visa	<p>EU citizens do not need any visa for Germany.</p> <p>Non-EU citizens need to obtain a visa <u>before</u> entering Germany <u>except</u> if:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. They are citizens of one of the following countries: Australia, Brazil, Canada, Israel, Japan, Korea (South), New Zealand, USA</li> <li>2. They live in a Schengen country and possess a valid residence permit for this Schengen country</li> </ol> <p>All Non-EU students need to apply for a residence permit (<i>Aufenthaltserlaubnis</i>) at the local Immigration Office (<i>Ausländerbehörde</i>) within 90 days after entering the Schengen Area <u>unless</u> they possess a visa that is valid for the whole planned duration of their stay in Germany and the Schengen Area. The application fee for the residence permit is 100 to 130 EUR.</p>
