


Students are strongly encouraged to arrive at least a week prior to Orientation week, however they should check their accommodation contract dates to ensure they will not be charged for extra nights outside their contract.

If a student is living off-campus, it is recommended to arrive 2 to 3 weeks prior to Orientation to ensure adequate housing is found.

** It is recommended not to depart before the final dates of the assessment period as students may have an exam up until the final date, which is a Saturday. Students can also again check their accommodation contract and are welcome to stay up until this time.
