TRANSPORT

There are regular bus services from UL to Limerick City Centre. The 304/304A bus leaves from the Stables every 15 minutes. You can pay using cash or use a Leap Card for a discounted fare.

GROCERIES

There are grocery stores located within walking distance of UL such as Aldi, Lidl and SuperValu. You can also order groceries online to be delivered at Tesco.ie or SuperValu.ie.

WIFI

Students can connect personal devices to the eduroam network. For initial connection please connect to setup_eduroam and follow the on-screen instructions.

FOOD

There are 17 restaurants and cafes located across campus. Alternatively, you can order food from local takeaway restaurants using apps such as JustEat or Deliveroo.

PHARMACY

The nearest pharmacy (or chemist) to the University campus is located in the Castletroy Park Retail Centre, across from the main entrance to the University (flagpoles entrance).

DOCTOR

The Student Health Centre is located in Block C, Level M of the Main Building. The closest GP is the Castletroy Park Medical Centre located across from the main entrance to the University.
