

Applying for an English Taught Course at the Faculty of Arts, Languages and Humanities

- As a non native speaker, you can only apply for an English taught course if you have a C1 certificate in English (IELTS, TOEIC, TOEFL or university level equivalent)
- Read carefully the enclosed copy of English Taught Courses these courses are only an option and not compulsory.
- Write your choices on the English Taught Course Learning Agreement
 the other Learning Agreement is for French taught courses only.
- You must add three choices given the limited number of places available on English Taught Corses, you may well not be accepted on your first choice.
- Have the Learning Agreement signed by your home university tutor.

Erasmus Students

- You must download your application, with the signed Learning Agreement, by 31st May 2021 at the latest.
- The results of your application will be sent to you at the latest by 15th July 2021.

Non European Students

- You must download your application, with the signed Learning Agreement, by 30th April 2021 at the latest.
- The results of your application will be sent to you at the latest by 15th
 June 2021
