


Course selection guide Södertörn University


To find courses available in English at Södertörn University please use the following [link](#). Once on the webpage, make sure to select the semester for when you will take courses at Södertörn University.

In the course description you can click on “Apply” to find out in which period the course is given. Weeks 35-39 corresponds to period 1, weeks 39-43 corresponds to period 2, weeks 44-48 corresponds to period 3 and weeks 48-02 corresponds to period 4. Here you could also see if the course is full time (100%) or part time (50%).

30 credits in Economics A and English B or equivalent.

Selection:
On the basis of previous university credits. Max. 165 credits may be taken into account.

Once you have looked through the list and selected courses corresponding to 30 credits over the four periods of the semester, you can fill in the course selection form that has been sent to you. You need to fill in your first choice for each period, followed by a second choice in case you are not accepted to your first. Make sure that if courses overlap between periods, for ex if you have chosen a 15 credits course in the first period, you do not need to make a choice for the second period as the course would run for two periods.

Course Selection for Exchange Students - Autumn Semester 2021

At Södertörn University, a semester is divided into four periods (one period is about five weeks, and a whole semester is 20 weeks). All students are expected to study full-time over the whole semester (30 ECTS credits/semester). Also, you can choose one full-time course or two part-time courses per period. Please read the following instructions carefully, fill out this form, save it as PDF, and submit it to your application in the Mobility Online by [May 1](#).

Instructions for course selection

- Please visit the website www.sh.se/courses for detailed information about the courses and prerequisites (please see attached Course Selection Guide.)
- If you choose a 30-ECTS course (ex., Comparative Public Law C, Economics B/C, English A/B/C, or Tourism Studies: City Tourism), please select it from the course list of Period 1.
- You can take "Swedish for International students 1, 2 or 3" as a part of full-time study OR an extra course on the top of full-time study load (up to two courses). If you wish to take it as an extra course, please select the check box below.
- It will not be possible to change your courses after the beginning of the semester, so contact us *before the semester starts if you need to make changes*.
