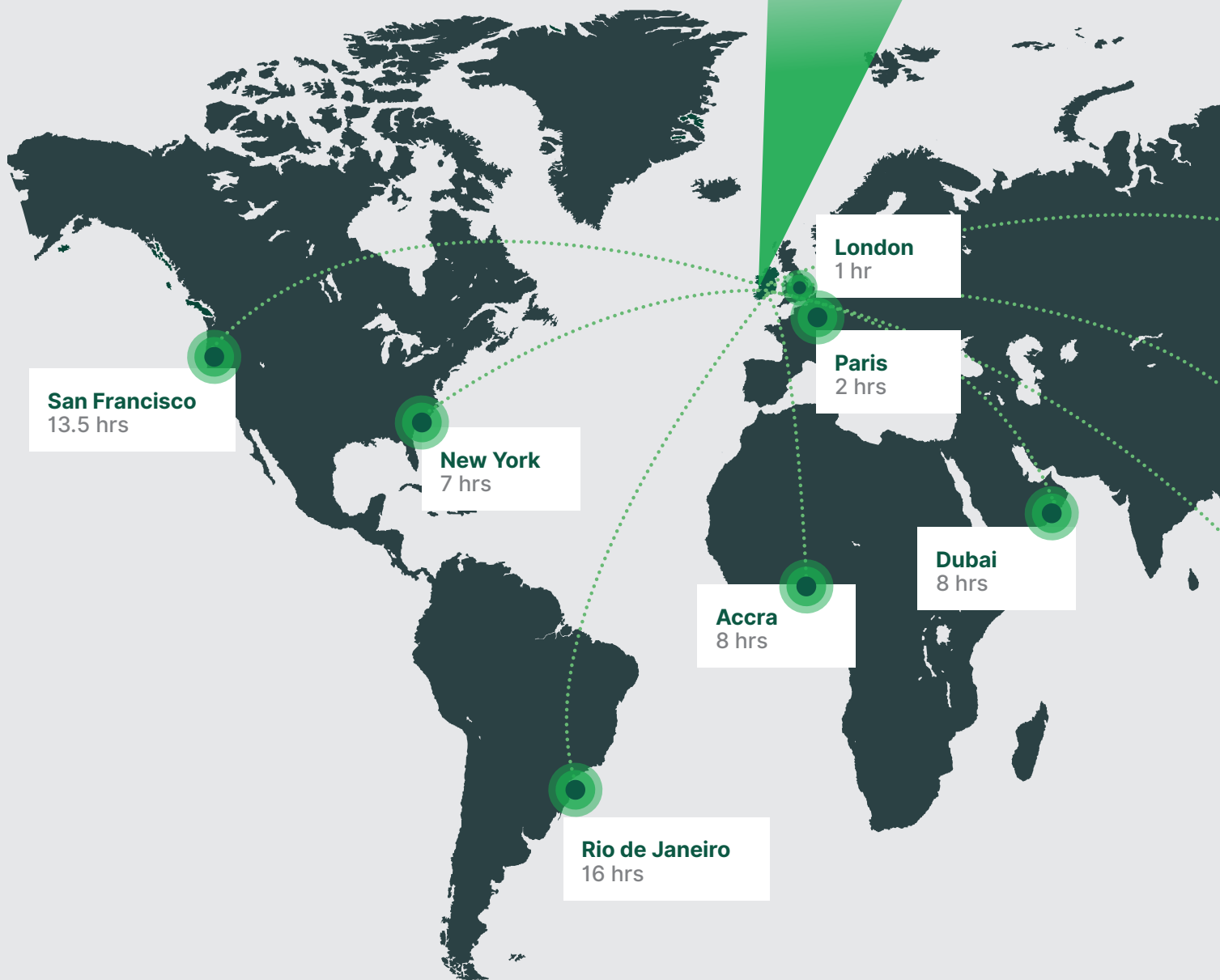

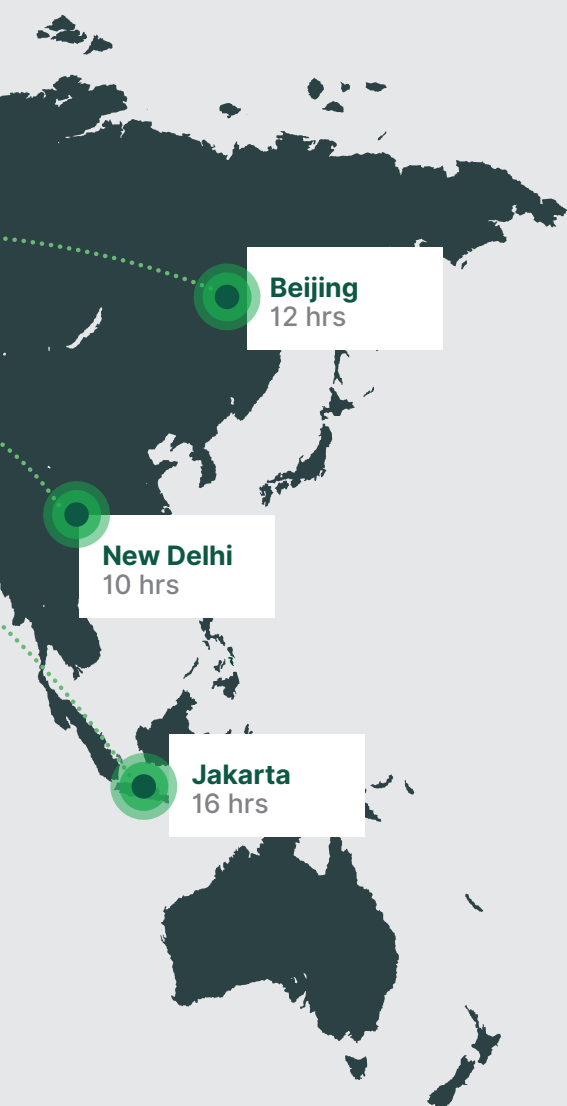
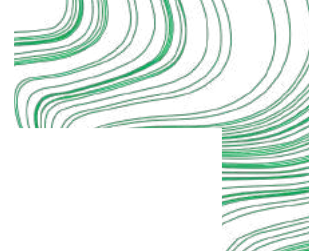

# Graduate Employment





## Achieving your potential

With a graduate employment rate that is consistently higher than the national average, University of Limerick's graduates find employment in all sectors of the economy. Over 97% of University of Limerick graduates successfully gained employment within six months of graduation or chose to continue with further studies.

Career Services provides information and support to help students to develop and implement effective career plans in preparation for graduation and beyond. Resources include careers advice and information, career planning seminars, on-campus career fairs, company presentations, mock interviews and job vacancy notifications.

## Opportunities, Student Work Permits and Graduate Employment

Non-EU students are permitted to work part-time up to 20 hours per week during the academic semester. During holiday periods (summer and Christmas breaks) students can work a full 40-hour week. Students graduating with a level-8 Honours Undergraduate Bachelor's Degree can apply for a 12-month graduate visa once final results are received. For students graduating with a minimum of level-9 Master's Degree, the period of employment is up to 24 months once final results are received. Graduates are eligible to work for up to 40 hours per week.

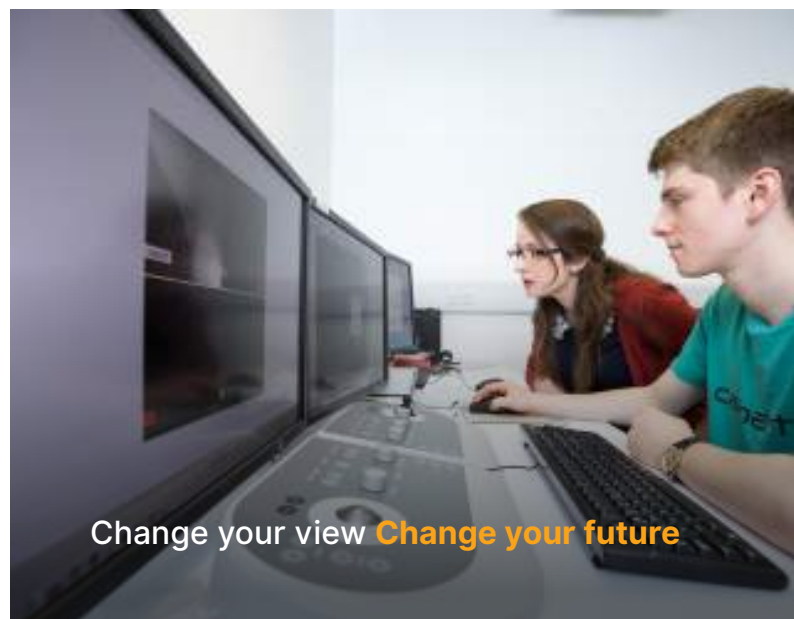

# Academic Entry Requirements

## Undergraduate Degrees

### Undergraduate Academic Entry Requirements

Undergraduate candidates must obtain an educational qualification equivalent to the Irish Leaving Certificate, A Levels (UK system) or International Baccalaureate.

Applicants must have certification in English, Mathematics and another language.

### Undergraduate Application Process and Deadline

Applicants can apply by visiting our website

[www.ul.ie](http://www.ul.ie)

Applications must be submitted by July 1st for September entry, but it is advisable to apply well in advance to secure your place. The processing time is ten working days. All applications must be accompanied by certification of all educational qualifications and certification demonstrating a high level of proficiency in English. Applicants who have not yet completed final exams or English language test, can receive a conditional offer by submitting predicted grades.

## Postgraduate Degrees

### Postgraduate Academic Requirements

Applicants must hold a qualification that is equivalent to an Irish or UK honours Bachelor's Degree (NQAI level 8). In many cases, the degree must be in a discipline relevant to the postgraduate degree sought.

### Postgraduate Application Process and Deadline

Applications must be submitted by July 1st for September entry, but it is advised to apply well in advance to secure your place. The processing time is approximately five to seven working days, subject to potential interviews with academic course leaders. Applicants can apply online through our website,

Applications must include certified results for all examinations mentioned on the application form and confirmation of the award of qualifications. Applicants who have not yet completed final exams or English language test, can receive a conditional offer by submitting predicted grades. Evidence of English language proficiency and certified translations of awards and transcripts should also be submitted.



## Scholarships

There are merit-based scholarships available to high achieving full-time non-EU undergraduate and postgraduate students. These are awarded across all faculties. University of Limerick offers a number of special international scholarships, which include the China Scholarship Council (CSC), Kemmy Business School Jim Kemmy India Scholarship, and the iGeneration Foundation (IGF) Scholarship. ## International Foundation Programme

This programme is managed by the University of Limerick Language Centre. It is a one-year full-time programme that offers international high school students an alternative route to undergraduate study. It is suitable for international students who do not hold qualifications equivalent to the Irish Leaving Certificate or A-Level, or who need a further boost to their English language skills. Students who have completed high school through the medium of English can choose a 'Foundation Plus' programme which focuses less on English language and more on academic modules.

There are three streams:

- Foundation in Science & Engineering
- Foundation in Arts, Humanities & Social Science
- Foundation in Business

The English language requirement for this programme is an IELTS score of 5.0, with no less than 5.0 in any one component, or the equivalent in a different qualification.

# English Language Entry Requirments



## Preparation for University English Language Programmes

**The University of Limerick Language Centre offers a variety of courses aimed at making sure that each student reaches their language goals.**

The Preparation for University programme caters for the language needs of students who intend to study for an undergraduate or postgraduate degree at University of Limerick. It is designed for students who have reached the academic entry requirements for their chosen degree but need to improve their English in order to meet the English language entry requirement. It is suitable for applicants who have received a conditional offer from University of Limerick. Programme length varies depending on level of English.

Students who achieve a final passing grade in pre-sessional English exams will have met the English language requirements for entry to the majority of programmes at University of Limerick (equivalent IELTS 6.5). It will not be necessary for such students to take an external English language test at the end of the Preparation for University programme.
