Practical information for exchange students





ACCOMODATION

> In a CROUS university hall of residence

Rooms are single rooms. Every room in a hall of residence has a surface of 9 m² and is equipped with: a bed, a desk, a washbasin, a cupboard, shelves.

The number of floors and rooms by floor vary according to residences.

However, you will find in every floor, toilets and showers (1 for 10 rooms) as well as a little kitchen where you can prepare breakfast. There is also a common living room or a television room in each residence.

- ✓ Traditional rooms of 9 m² having collective kitchen areas, rooms of work, meeting and relaxation. Toilet blocks on each floor.
 - Rent: 165.00 € per month
- ✓ Renovated rooms between 9 m² and 12 m², having a privative bathroom. Cooking and space of relaxation on each floor.
 Rent: 244.00€ per month

You can choose the kind of room you prefer. Please notice that we advise you to choose the rooms with own bathroom: they are more comfortable and most of the time have been renovated recently, that's why they are also more expensive.

You will be informed of the result of your application by email, from the end of June (fall semester & academic year) and from the end of November (spring semester).

FRENCH LANGUAGE COURSE

You can benefit from a free French language course in Rennes (for one semester) at the **Rennes International Center for the Study of French as a Foreign Language**.

A French language course can be taken on a volunteer basis: 4 hours per week, 6 ECTS credits.
This course is free for one semester (fall or spring).
