





Regions of Employment



Global

Internationally, the largest percentage of graduates went to EU countries, with 33%. Sectors with the greatest representation were Financial, Insurance & Real Estate (25%), Industry (25%), the Education Sector(13%), and Information & Communication (13%). North America was the next largest percentage, at 23%. Of those, Education, followed by Industry, Information & Communication, and Wholesale and Retail trade were the sectors where graduates reported employment.



Ireland

In Ireland, the Mid West took the largest percentage of Graduates from the Kemmy Business School, at 41%. Of those, the greatest number went to the Financial, Insurance & Retail sector, followed by Industry, Professional, scientific and Technical, and Information & Communication.

The area with the next highest percentage of graduates reporting employment was in the East, at 30%. Sectors reported there included Financial, Insurance and Real Estate, Industry, Professional, Scientific & Technical, and Information & Communication.
