








# Regions of Employment



## Global

The greatest percentage of graduates working overseas went to the EU, at 45%, out of 78 respondents. Of those, the largest percentage was in the Education sector, with 49%, followed by Financial, Insurance & Real Estate with 11&%. Great Britain took the second largest number with 28%. The sectors with the most reported graduate jobs were Education, Other, and Professional, Scientific and Technical, each with just under 14%.



### Ireland

The Mid West took the largest percentage of graduates of AHSS, at 43% of 400 responses. Of those,, Financial, Insurance & Real Estate (21%), and Education (15%) were the sectors most represented. The East of the country took the next largest, with 27%. Of those, Financial, Insurance & Real Estate (26%) was the sector that featured most, followed by Education (13%).
