









### Regions of Employment



#### Global

Internationally, 82 graduates reported working overseas. The largest percentage were in North America (46%), and Great Britan (35%). In North America, the sectors with the most graduates were Human Health & Social Work (84%), and Education (8%). In Great Britain, Human Health and Social work (59%), and Education (21%).



#### Ireland

Of the 575 graduates, The Mid West took the largest percentage of graduates, at 37%. Of those, 54% were in the fields of Human Health and social work. Education was the next highest, with 29%.

The East took 31%% of graduates, with 55% of those going again to Human Health and Social work, and 27% to Education.
