submit official TOEFL, IELTS, Cambridge, or DuoLingo scores meeting the following requirements for acceptance.

TOEFL, IELTS, Cambridge or DuoLingo scores for students who are not graduating from an English educational system within the last two years, or for whom English is not the primary language.

- > TOEFL minimum score of 213 (computer based), 550 (paper based), or 79 (IBT-Internet based)
 - >IELTS minimum score of 6.0
 - >Cambridge minimum score of 170
- >DuoLingo minimum score of 105 (link to DuoLingo test:

Language proficiency exams are not required of those exchange students whose native language is English.

Students whose native language is not English but the primary medium of instruction at their home university is English must:

- 1.) provide/upload a letter from their home university and signed by their International Office or university representative stating that the program delivery method is in English and the student has been taking courses in English for two (2) years or more.
- 2.) interview with a staff member of our Embry-Riddle Language Institute (ERLI)

When the interview is completed, ERLI will provide the ERAU Office of Global Engagement with a result of pass or not pass for the applying exchange student.
