Nomination Process	The standing procedure to be followed is that the home University first nominates the students filling out an online form previously provided. <u>Fall semester/Entire academic course deadline</u> → May 16 th <u>Spring semester deadline</u> → October 10 th

Online registration	The student will be requested to access to the online platform and submit the Application form and the following documentation: 1. Passport copy 2. ID card photo 3. Insurance Form properly filled in and signed 4. Official Transcript of Records 5. Language certification (if required) 6. Course Enrollment Form
