


We, the University

courage – in turning problems into challenges, in defending important aspects of goal-setting, and engaging in useful pursuits;


responsibility – in planning and the actions which are focused on society, the upcoming generations, as well as the limited time and resources that we use.



By believing that science can change the world for the better, we are implementing research projects that benefit society

We continually invest in the development and the high quality of our research. Our university is among the most active research institutions in the country. Our researchers focus on the observation, analysis, and diagnosis of human behavior. All these efforts are geared towards translating research results into practical implementation, which meets human needs and eliminates social problems.

Every day, close to 400 researchers from over 20 research centers carry out research, whilst helping to develop scientific disciplines and create innovative solutions. As a leading institution among grant recipients in Poland, we conduct close to 250 multifaceted, international research projects annually. Most of all, however, we carry out research that has a great chance of being implemented.

By working in many disciplines and areas, we educate new generations of researchers

We understand that innovation requires teamwork. Therefore, we go beyond the walls of our university, creating interdisciplinary teams that encompass the humanities, social sciences, engineering, new technologies as well as industrial and service sectors. We actively participate in international exchanges of ideas to develop innovative solutions that can improve the quality of people's lives.

During the relatively short history of our university, we have granted nearly 400 doctoral degrees, 90 post-doctoral degrees (habilitacja), and have successfully completed 11 procedures related to granting professorial titles. We are authorized to grant doctoral and post-doctoral degrees in seven disciplines.




By working in an inspiring and dedicated team, we ensure the highest quality of education

We are aware that behind each of the disciplines, there are people with their own ambitions and ideas. We are proud to have leading academics in the disciplines of the humanities and social sciences among our teaching staff. Our faculty includes winners of the *MISTRZ* (MASTER) grant scheme, provided by Poland's National Science Center (NCN) for distinguished researchers, and winners of the so-called Polish 'Nobel' Prize awarded by the Foundation for Polish Science (FNP).


SWPS University is among Poland's top universities, which is confirmed by the prestigious "A+ category" the university has received in Psychology, awarded by the Ministry of Education and Science [MEiN]. An "A category" has been granted to five disciplines, including Literary Studies, Culture and Religion Studies, Sociology, Political Science and Public Administration, and Fine Arts and Art Conservation, and a "B+ category" in Law.

We publish the results of our research in prestigious Polish and international journals. Every year, we are among the top recipients of grants from Poland's National Science Centre, a government agency, supervised by the Ministry of Education and Science, aimed at supporting basic research in Poland. We ensure that our researchers have the best possible environment to carry out their work, which is confirmed by the HR Excellence in Research certificate.

We continuously expand our education program, aligning it with the needs of students and the labor market. We observe and analyze evolving trends to ensure that our study programs offer numerous development paths, here and now, and also for the job market of tomorrow. Thanks to this approach, our graduates are confident, socially engaged, and eager to pursue knowledge.



By ensuring the quality of our education, we provide others with solid foundations for development

Our commitment to and focus on the quality and effectiveness of education are recognized by others. The Polish Accreditation Committee has positively assessed our drive to improve the quality of our programs on numerous occasions. Every year we rank among Poland's top universities. We are also positively assessed in the international rankings.

For us, the educational role of our university is of paramount importance. While creating our study programs, we collaborate with people and institutions from various business sectors and with universities from other countries, to provide our students with networking opportunities in academia across the globe. Simultaneously, we strive to provide our university community with the best possible environment for learning and development. Therefore, we systematically invest not only in new study programs, but also in our infrastructure.



By employing the best lecturers, we ensure a comprehensive education for our students

Our faculty comprises close to 2,000 lecturers, including acclaimed professors, authors of university handbooks, members of international research teams, key opinion-leaders, and experienced practitioners. Our students learn from professionals representing various sectors of industry. These professionals include renowned journalists, designers, computer programmers, psychotherapists, philologists, spokespersons, former judges, attorneys-at-law, and business leaders.

There are no fillers in our study programs and our teaching format is not limited solely to lectures. Our students participate in workshops, projects, mock trials, and business case studies. They learn in specialized labs and studios. Furthermore, they are supported by our Office of Career Services, which helps them in planning successful careers every step of the way, from job counseling, through internships to workshops with employers.

SCOBY

SCOBY is organic food packaging, an alternative to single use plastics. Once you are done with SCOBY as packaging, you can eat it or throw it on a compost heap. The biodegradable material was developed as a graduation project of an Industrial Design student at SWPS University's School of Form.

Photon

Photon is an innovative educational robot, aligned to a child's development. The robot helps children learn new technology-related skills and stimulates social and emotional development. Children teach the robot basic skills and ideas using a mobile app. The project was developed by a team of experts from SWPS University's Business Engagement Center and StresLab, including Katarzyna Żukowska, Krzysztof Rzeńca, and Natalia Michalak.





RESQL mobile app

RESQL is a mobile app enabling students to anonymously report acts of violence directly to the teaching staff. RESQL has the potential to become a breakthrough in preventing peer violence in schools. It has already been named best social innovation and won the Grand Prix at the 2020 INTARG competition. RESQL was developed by psychologists from SWPS University, Małgorzata Wójcik, Ph.D. and Radosław Kaczan, Ph.D.

Selected research and implementation projects carried out at SWPS University

Through conducting projects and research, we believe that small steps can turn into milestones

One of the main pillars of SWPS University is the ability to shape the surrounding environment. With this intention in mind, we are implementing a variety of initiatives, which seek to diagnose and resolve the challenges of the contemporary world. We understand that change for the better requires dialogue and cooperation, therefore, we step outside of our lecture halls, and closely collaborate with our community, business partners and the world of arts and culture.



We ensure that our students empathize with other people and we encourage them to get involved. By promoting social engagement, we show students that they can make positive changes in the world. Together, we search for solutions to people's problems and for answers that meet these needs. We ensure that our ideas can be implemented in everyday life.

By being sensitive to the needs of others, we undertake initiatives aimed at improving quality of life

We observe and analyze the challenges that people face. Therefore, our research is oriented towards practical applications that meet the real needs of people, for example, *BLIŻEJ* (Closer) – a program focused on eliminating peer discrimination among teenagers; MEMO – a tool supporting cognitive functions in senior citizens; TEMPEST – a program helping to prevent obesity in children and young adults; and RESQL – a mobile app that helps prevent violence in schools.

We support children and the young people of Warsaw by collaborating with the non-profit organization Stowarzyszenie Wspólne Podwórko (Common Playground Association). We offer professional services and psychology and psychiatric counseling in our Cognitive-Behavioral Therapy Clinic in Warsaw as well as in Poradnia Psychologiczno-Pedagogiczna (Psychological and Pedagogical Clinic), Środowiskowe Centrum Zdrowia Psychicznego (Community Center for Mental Health), and Klinika Rodzina – Para – Jednostka (Family – Couple – Individual Clinic) in Poznań.

By staying close to people and their problems, we share our knowledge and experience

We tackle critical social issues by collaborating with business partners, local governments and NGOs. We are expanding the scope of our consulting and training services addressed to the public and business sector. Our Center for Knowledge Transfer supports researchers in liaising with the business sector and in commercializing research.

The popularization of science beyond the academic community is an important aspect of SWPS University being socially engaged. We develop our own media, organize a variety of online meetings, and offer numerous videos and podcasts. We publish popular science blogs for those interested in the latest advancements in science. Our efforts have been rewarded in content popularity rankings, a continually growing number of followers on our media platforms, and professional awards.
