[Georgia Tech](#) is one of the top research universities in the United States, distinguished by its commitment to improving the human condition through advanced science and technology. [Majors and degrees](#) are offered through the colleges of Design, Computing, Engineering, Sciences, the Scheller College of Business, and the Ivan Allen College of Liberal Arts.

Campus

Georgia Tech's beautiful 400-acre, tree-lined campus is located in the heart of Atlanta, Georgia. The campus is a comfortable, yet stimulating living and learning environment, with virtually every amenity close at hand. Within an easy walk to campus are green spaces and parks, including Centennial Olympic Park, Piedmont Park, and the Atlanta BeltLine — a network of public parks, multi-use trails, and multiple public transit options.



Atlanta

Atlanta is the capital of the state of Georgia, the site of the 1996 Olympic Games, and one of the fastest-growing cities in the United States. It is home to over 6 million people and boasts the busiest airport in the world. Atlanta, the undisputed business and cultural center of the southeast, is consistently ranked as one of the top 10 places to for high-tech and international career opportunities. The moderate cost of living, which is below the national average, and the pleasant climate, which permits year-round outdoor activities, makes Atlanta appealing to many.



Nomination Deadlines

- Fall Semester/Academic Year: March 1
- Spring Semester: September 1

Semester Application Deadline

- Fall: April 1st
- Spring: October 1st

Arrival on Campus

Accepted students should attempt to arrive at Georgia Tech the week before classes begin in order to attend Orientation and complete OIE Check-In.



Nomination Instructions



Exchange Partners must first confirm how many spots are available for the upcoming semester before nominating students.

After confirming spots, please complete the Online Nomination Form sent to you via email.

You will be asked to submit the following:

- Name
- Date of Birth & Gender
- Program of Study
- Level of Study (Undergraduate, Graduate)
- Email Address
- Address to mail DS-2019

After the nomination deadline, all nominations will be reviewed. Partner institutions will receive an email confirming the student nominations.

Nominated students will then receive specific instructions on the application process. All application items must be received by the appropriate deadline.

Graduate Applications: Please note that the application process for graduate students can vary by program, and application deadlines can be earlier. Admission is determined by the academic department and Graduate Studies.

Original Documents Submitted Electronically

Students must request the following documents be sent directly from their home university:

- Official Transcript (in English)
- GT Incoming Exchange Permission Form

Students must request the following test score reports be sent directly from the testing agency:

- English Proficiency Certification: TOEFL (minimum iBT 95) or IELTS (minimum 7.0).
Note that a TOEFL/IELTS score reports is valid for 2 years.
- GRE/GMAT (required for Graduate students)

Immigration Documents



Once accepted by Georgia Tech as a non-degree exchange student, OIE will email the student with a link to the DS-2019 Information e-form requesting the following documents:

- **Copy of Passport (biographical page)**
- **Financial Documentation**
 - **Please download and submit a Financial Certification Form with necessary financial documentation of funding to the e-form in iStart**
 - **Please visit <https://iss.oie.gatech.edu/content/financial-document-requirements>**

Georgia Tech will then issue and mail the DS-2019 form according to the preference indicated in the nomination form. Student must then:

- **Pay I-901 SEVIS fee at fmjfee.com**
- **Apply for a J-1 Visa**
 - **Please visit travel.state.gov and j1visa.state.gov for visa application information.**

Please note: Visas can take several weeks to process. Students should apply for the J-1 Visa as soon as possible.

When traveling to the United States, student's passport must be valid at least 6 months into the future.
