| How to apply for student housing | <p>JYU has reserved a limited quota of furnished study-bedrooms for exchange students from the Central Finland Student Housing Foundation (KOAS) and Soihtu Kortepohja. Students can apply for housing via a separate form during the following application periods:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Autumn semester: 7 May - 20 May</li> <li>• Spring semester: 18 October - 1 November</li> </ul> <p>Priority is given to students coming from FORTHEM partner universities and students coming through the following exchange programmes, provided they apply in time: Bilateral, Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility, ISEP.</p> |

| <b>Tenancy period</b>                     | Students staying in apartments within the reserved quota must sign a tenancy agreement for a <b>fixed term</b> . The fixed-term tenancy agreement cannot be terminated within the tenancy period. |
| <b>Availability of the apartments</b>     | Student housing is not guaranteed to all applicants, especially in the autumn semester. Students coming for the spring semester have better chances of getting a room from KOAS or Soihtu.        |

| <b>EU/EEA/EFTA citizens</b>  | Citizens of the EU/EEA/EFTA countries do not need a residence permit but must register their right to reside in Finland if their continuous stay in Finland lasts for longer than 90 days. | <b>Non-EU/EEA/EFTA citizens</b>                                    | Citizens of non-EU/EEA/EFTA countries who wish to stay in Finland for more than 90 days must be in possession of a residence permit when entering the country. An application for the permit should be submitted electronically at <a href="https://migri.fi/en">migri.fi/en</a> as soon as the student has received the letter of admission. In addition to the electronic application, all applicants must visit a Finnish embassy in person. | <b>Non-EU/EEA/EFTA citizens studying in an EU/EEA/EFTA country</b> | Citizens of a non-EU/EEA/EFTA country who study in an EU/EEA/EFTA country as a degree student should have a valid residence permit in the country where they study as a degree student. In addition, a mobility notification should be submitted to the Finnish Immigration Service.
