Immigration

Many non-EU students entering Ireland must show airport officials a valid entry visa. North American students do not require an entry visa but are required to have an offer letter from UL at the entry airport and will be required to register with INIS for the duration of their stay. The immigration registration fee is €300

Accommodation

On-campus accommodation is available for Study Abroad Students, which ranges from approximately €2,600 to €3,900.

This cost includes Electricity, Gas Heating, TV License, Cable TV, Wi-fi & General Maintenance. Deposit payable of €500.

Language Requirements

Students whose first language is not English must show evidence of a high level of proficiency in spoken and written English.



Health Insurance

Non-EU nationals must hold valid medical insurance for the duration of their study in Ireland.

Modules/ECTS Credits

A normal semester load at the University of Limerick is 24 - 30 ECTS credits per semester (12 - 15 US Credits).

Academic Transcripts

A digital transcript will be available to students and partners within 5 weeks of results being released. UL uses Digitary, an online secure document platform to enable applicants, students and graduates to access certified and secure electronic documents (e.g. transcripts, parchments and official letters).
