Learn to prepare for controls based on security concerns as well as regulations governing trade in high risk and dual use goods.

You will know how to use simplifications, authorisations and special procedures to minimise cost and disruption. You will understand how to deal with different authorities, particularly in Ireland, Northern Ireland and the UK.

You will be comfortable with the procedures for importing, and you will know how to research the rules and regulations of export markets. Overall, you will have a broad professional competence, and the ability to locate the most up to date relevant information on specific issues.

Candidate Profile and Requirements

Programme participants should be involved in international trade, transport or Customs services. Your role should involve one or more of; preparation of documents, managing the logistics function, import procurement or export sales, customs compliance, provision of customs services and supply chain planning and management.

A strong knowledge of the compliance requirements of International Trade is required. Recognised prior learning (RPL) will be considered for suitable applicants.
