PERINATAL BEREAVEMENT AND LOSS*

Module Overview

The quality of perinatal bereavement care delivered during the parents grieving journey can have longlasting consequences as it may have a significant impact in shaping their healing process and may directly influence how they cope following their baby's death. This module supports midwives and other health care professionals to work more effectively with bereaved parents and their families experiencing perinatal loss.

**This module can be taken as a stand-alone module or as part of the MSc Nursing/MSc Perinatal Mental Health programmes offered by the Department of Nursing and Midwifery. Students can take up to three modules without enrolling on a full programme of study and programme enrolment occurs each Aug/Sept.*
