 - Rooms and facilities

Answer Scale

All questions are answered using 5-point Likert scale ranging from 1 to 5, where:

- 1. Very dissatisfied
- 2. Dissatisfied
- 3. Neutral
- 4. Satisfied
- 5. Very satisfied
